

Overview

Electronic Document Storage (EDS) in KC is MIT’s digital solution to streamline collaboration and provide improved access to proposal and award documents. It enables **24/7 access** to Institute Proposal (IP), Award, and Subaward attachments for all research stakeholders, including PIs.

How to Get Access

Access Permissions

- Access is based on **Roles + Unit Authorization** via the **Roles DB**.
- **Required EDS Roles:**
 - View shared award documents KC
 - View shared institutional proposal doc KC
 - View shared subaward docs KC
 - View dev proposal attachment KC
 - View all shared documents KC (grants all of the above)
- Module roles (e.g., “View Award KC”) do **not** include attachment access. Document roles must be added separately.


Role Setup:

- Contact your **DLCI Financial Authorizer** to be assigned a role in Roles DB

Navigating EDS

For PIs & Researchers:

- Go to **KC Dashboard** → **My Research Activity** → **Project Documents tab**
- Click **View** next to an award to access linked proposal/award documents
- No KC role required —uses MIT Touchstone
